

ORDINANCE NO. 676

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR PARTIAL-YEAR, ODD-EVEN/DATE-SIDE ALTERNATING OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING.

THE CITY OF PETOSKEY ORDAINS:

- (1) **Time and Manner of Permitted Parking.** Between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M., Sundays through Saturdays, annually, from December 1 to the following April 1, on-street parking shall be permitted on all public streets within the City only as follows, unless otherwise authorized by the City Manager:
 - (a) **Odd-Numbered Dates.** On all odd-numbered dates, all motor vehicles shall be parked on the odd-numbered side of the street. Odd-numbered dates shall mean the 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 13th, 15th, 17th, 19th, 21st, 23rd, 25th, 27th, 29th and 31st days of each month.
 - (b) **Even-Numbered Dates.** On all even-numbered dates, all motor vehicles shall be parked on the even-numbered side of the street. Even-numbered dates shall mean the 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, 10th, 12th, 14th, 16th, 18th, 20th, 22nd, 24th, 26th, 28th, and 30th days of each month.
 - (c) **Odd-Numbered Side of Street.** The "*odd-numbered side of the street*" shall mean the side of the public street that is adjacent to properties that are designated by odd-numbered addresses. Odd-numbered addresses shall be those that end with a digit that is a 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9.
 - (d) **Even-Numbered Side of Street.** The "*even-numbered side of the street*" shall mean the side of the public street that is adjacent to properties that are designated by even-numbered addresses. Even-numbered addresses shall be those that end with a digit that is a 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8.
- (2) **Central Business District Exception.** The provisions in this Section shall not apply to public streets within the B-2 Central Business District zone. Within the B-2 Central Business District zone, no motor vehicle shall be parked on any public street between the hours of 3:00 A.M. and 5:00 A.M., Sundays through Saturdays, annually, from December 1 to the following April 1.
- (3) **Violations.** Any person who violates any provision herein shall be responsible for a civil infraction, the fine for which City Council may, from time to time, set by resolution.
- (4) **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect fourteen (14) days following its enactment and shall be published once within seven (7) days after its enactment as provided by Charter.
