A special-session meeting of the City of Petoskey City Council was held in the City Hall Community Room, Petoskey, Michigan, on Saturday, September 13, 2014. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M. and a roll call then determined that the following were

Interviews & Appoint City Manager

City Councilmembers interviewed the remaining two candidates, David Mackie and William Reynolds, for the City Manager position. City Councilmembers discussed the candidates strengths and weaknesses and who would be the best fit for the Petoskey community.

Mayor Fraser asked for public comments and heard that all four candidates were competent, but that three stood out.

City Councilmember Marshall moved that, seconded by City Councilmember Wills to appoint William Reynolds as City Manager for the City of Petoskey pursuant to Chapter 5 of the City Charter, contingent upon:

1. The Candidate satisfactorily passing a Background Investigation; and
2. City Council's approving the terms and conditions of an Employment Contract.
