Tour Possible Ernest
Hemingway Statue Locations

City Council at their March 16, 2015 meeting requested to conduct a walking tour to review potential locations for an Ernest Hemingway statue to be donated to the City by Mr. Robert Dau.

City Councilmembers visited all eight sites and also discussed a new location in Pennsylvania Park near the Gazebo, where a park bench is located in the middle of a Y formed by the sidewalks. Following the site visits City Council returned to City Hall.

City Council reconvened at 6:30 P.M., in the City Hall Council Chambers to further discuss the potential locations. Councilmembers narrowed the 8 proposed sites down to three including; across the street from the Perry Hotel at Park Avenue and Bay Street, the Carnegie Library and the History Museum. Council also added the additional location near the gazebo in Pennsylvania Park as a possible location.

City Council will further discuss this matter at their next regularly scheduled meeting on April 20, 2015.
