## CITY COUNCIL

January 3, 2017

A regular meeting of the City of Petoskey City Council was held in the City Hall Council Chambers, Petoskey, Michigan, on Tuesday, January 3, 2017. This meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M.; then, after a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, as part of the City Council's annual organizational meeting, the City Clerk-Treasurer administered oaths of office to Mayor-elect John Murphy, and City Councilmembers-elect Izzy Lyman and Jeremy Wills following their elections to the City Council at the General Election of November 8, 2016.
